FY 2025 ArcGIS Survey123 Forest Stewardship Plan Implementation Monitoring User's Guide

January 31, 2025

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Introduction

The Forest Service's Forest Stewardship Program uses Esri's ArcGIS Survey123 application to better collaborate with our State and Territorial partners in reporting Stewardship Plan Implementation Monitoring data for the FY2025 monitoring season. This reporting builds upon prior year surveys (FY's 2021,2022, 2023, & 2024) with no new updates to the form, but new updates on plans to be monitored. To report data through this survey, the required user must have a US Forest Service ArcGIS Online (AGOL) account (username and password) that has been assigned to you by a Forest Stewardship Program Regional Coordinator. Please ensure you have the correct login credentials to access the application. This form was developed by Robert J Geitner (robert.geitner@usda.gov) and for FY2022 and FY2023 was administered by Tom Luther (now retired). 

Accessing the Stewardship Monitoring Survey123 Form from your computer

1) Click the <u>https://arcg.is/04KvC11</u> or scan the QR code below.



2) Data collection is supported via two options "Open in Browser" which requires an internet connection or "Open in the Survey123 field app" which supports both connected and disconnected data collection. If your mobile device does not have the Survey123 field app, please download, install, and then open the field app.


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- 5) Search and download ArcGIS Survey123 to your mobile device through the App Store (iOS) or Google Play (Android). The app is free, but you must be connected to the internet (wireless or cellular) to download it.
- 6) Open the ArcGIS Survey123 app and allow the app to access your mobile device's camera. Regarding the use of location, allowing access to your mobile device's location is not necessary for Stewardship Monitoring, but it will avoid annoying popups.
- 7) Click "Sign in with ArcGIS Online" and enter your state or territorial natural resources agency AGOL username and password and allow Survey123 to use your location either "while using the app" or "allow once."




 Click "Download surveys" to download the "FY2025 FSP Plan Implementation Monitoring" survey form to your device for off-line use.


1) Click the link to access the results pages for the Stewardship Monitoring Survey:



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
5) Double click a record in the table to view the details for that record:

7) Click the "Export" button to export database to CSV, Excel, KML, Shapefile, of File Geodatabase formats:




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8) If you simply Click the "Export" button in Step 7, which will export all entries you have created. Otherwise, if you'd like to export a subset of the records you have collected, or a single entry, simply select that entry from the map, and click 'Selected Records Only' to export the data to a CSV, Excel, KML, Shapefile, of File Geodatabase.



9) Select which folder you'd like to export your compressed data package to access it on your device.
